According to a report from *Chorus America*, joining choir helps children improve study habits and learn important social skills such as emotion control, self discipline, and friendship.

After surveying from over 3000 parents, choristers, teachers, 70% of the parents indicated that after joining choir, their children showed an improvement in confidence, memory, and academics.

80% of teachers agreed that after their students joined choir, they showed better social skills and grades. 90% of teachers indicated that there is a direct correlation between choir practice and positive behavior at school. Over 50% of teachers encourage parents to let their children join choir.
